

Wolverines beat Roanoke teams

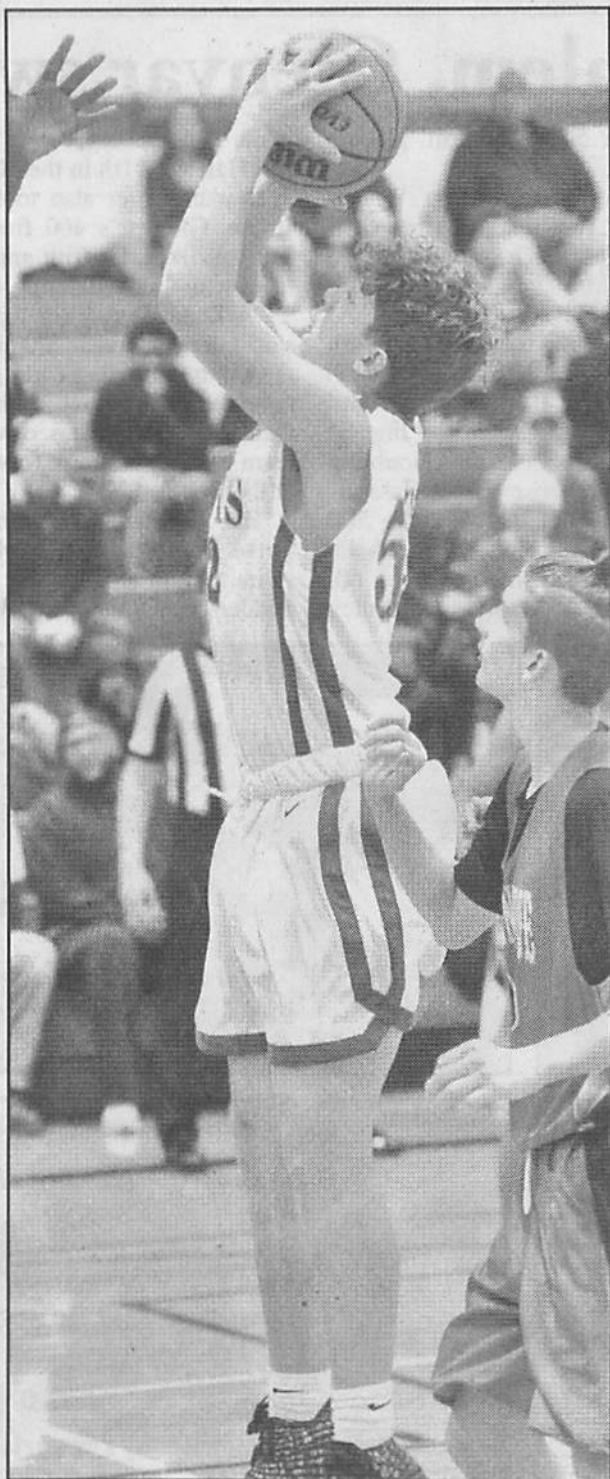
The Andrew Lewis Middle School basketball teams went 4-0 over a three day span as both the boys and girls defeated Breckinridge at home and Woodrow Wilson in Roanoke.

Last Thursday in Salem the Wolverines hosted a doubleheader against Breckinridge. The girls opened the twin bill and took a 42-15 win over the visitors. Daisy-Ann Dawyot had a big night with 20 points, 10 rebounds and five steals while Shaniya Robinson had 10 points and six boards and Bailey Stratton had six points and six assists.

In the nightcap the boys took a 46-39 win as Payton Lewis and Jaelyn Allen led the scoring and rebounding.

On Saturday both Lewis teams played in the Roanoke City Middle School Showcase and both picked up wins over Woodrow Wilson opponents. The girls won in a romp, 45-5, as Dawyot scored 18 and Robinson had six points. The boys then won 49-38.
