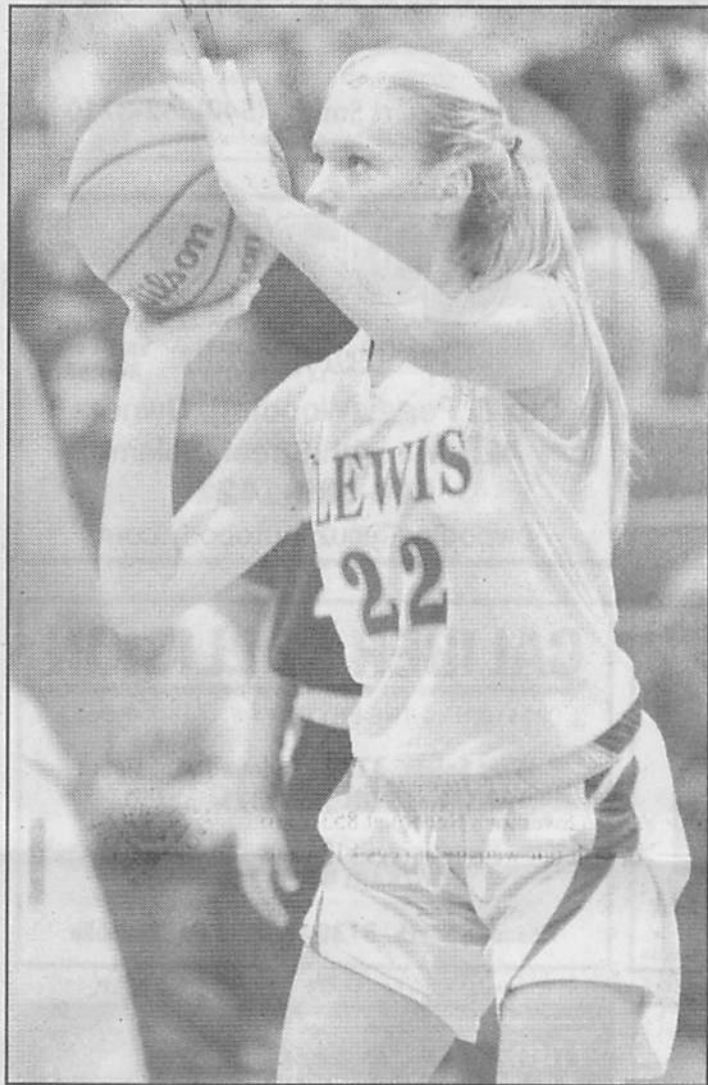


AL basketball season ends this week
