

## Lewis basketball teams play Northside today

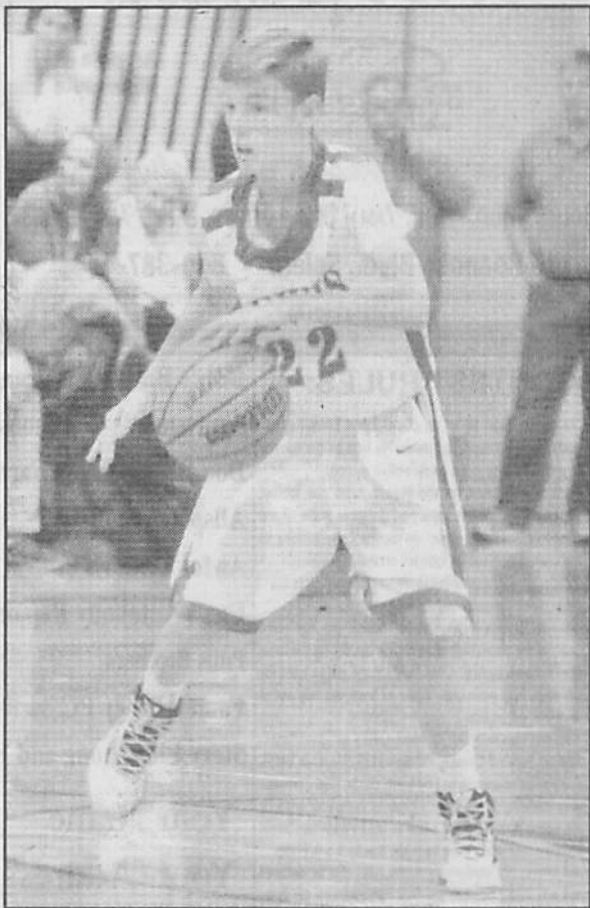
On Monday in Salem Lewis hosted Cave Spring Middle School and were defeated, 49-30.
