

Lewis girls beat Byrd, 46-1

The Andrew Lewis boys and girls basketball teams will be in action today with the boys hosting Hidden Valley and the girls visiting HV Middle School.

The girls remained undefeated with a 46-1 win over William Byrd last week in Vinton. Maddie Smith had 11 points for Lewis, Daisy Dawyot had 10 and Brooklyn Smith scored eight points. Smith and Dawyot had six rebounds each and Zoe Robtison had four assists.

"I thought the girls played with great defensive intensity the whole game," said AL coach Nat Franklin. "We missed a few lay-ups on the offensive end but an overall great effort."

Meanwhile, the boys are still look-

ing for a win after dropping two games last week. Salem lost to Byrd at home, 38-26, then dropped a 50-9 game at Lucy Addison.
