

# Lewis girls finish 14-0

The Andrew Lewis Middle School girls completed an undefeated season last week, including a 40-17 win over Northside Middle School. The Wolverines finished 14-0 and the Norsewomen lost just twice, both times to Lewis.

"The girls were really excited for this game after our earlier season game against Northside, and it showed in their focus and defensive effort," said coach Nat Franklin. "I'm very happy with the way our girls played. This game was the talk of the middle school girls' season."

Daisy Ann Dawyot led the Wolverines with 16 points, tying her season high. She also had eight rebounds and four steals.

Maddie Smith had 11 rebounds and five points for the Wolverines. Zoe Robtison had four points and four assists and Bayleigh Booth and Brooklyn Smith had four points each.

On Thursday in Vinton the girls put a big bow on an undefeated season with a 52-11 win over William Byrd Middle School. Summer Bayne had a season

high 22 points in this one, including four three pointers, while Booth had eight points and My'la Green scored seven points and pulled down eight boards. Dawyot had 10 rebounds and Robtison had seven steals and eight assists.

The win completed a third consecutive undefeated season for the Wolverines.

"This has been such a great group of girls to coach," said Franklin. "They put in a lot of work during the summer and it paid off. I look forward to seeing these girls continue to improve and play a big part in Andrew Lewis and Salem Spartans girls' basketball."

Meanwhile in Salem, the boys finished on the other end of the spectrum with a 42-29 loss to Byrd on Thursday. The Wolverines finished 0-14.

"We struggled all season long to get anything going," said coach Brandon Keith. "We also were without one of our top returning and overall players for the entire season, which definitely played a role in our constant struggle to compete."
