The Andrew Lewis High School basketball teams will conclude their seasons today when the boys and girls take on William Byrd. The girls will play at Lewis and the boys are in Vinton, both at 5 pm.

The girls will be trying to cap off an undefeated season after whipping on the Norse girls at Northside Monday, 40-9.
