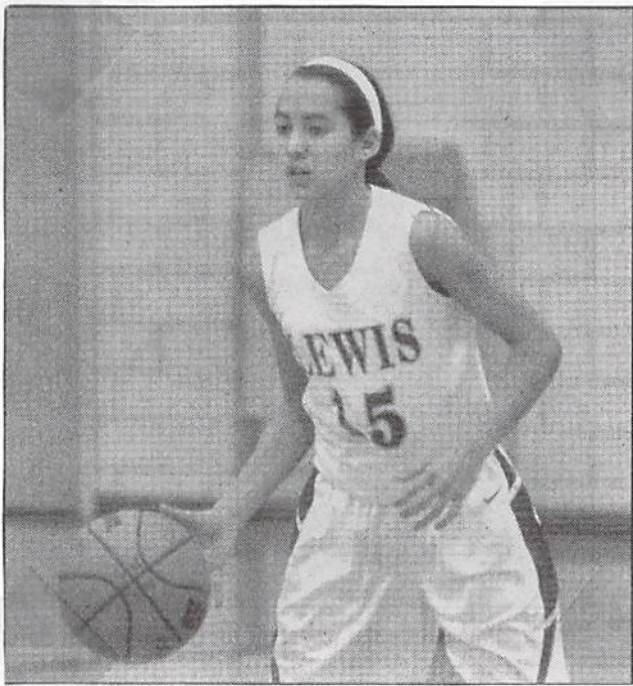

## Lewis girls knock B'Burg from ranks of the unbeaten in middle school basketball

The Andrew Lewis Middle School sports teams returned to action last week after the holiday break. Both basketball teams and the wrestling team were in action last Wednesday.

The Wolverine Boys basketball team dropped a 41-22 decision, at Blacksburg. Unable to find much offense until the third quarter, the Wolverines struggled against a taller opponent, who played spirited defense all evening.

Aden Britton led Lewis' scorers with six points, while Jack Gladden added four. The Wolverines were scheduled to host Clifton Forge in a re-match of the season opener Tuesday.

The Lady Wolverines took on an undefeated Blacksburg team and prevailed, 29-28. Tied up at 28-28 with 11 seconds left, Alla Daniel took the inbounds and passed the ball up court to Azyah Burnette under the basket. Burnette briefly lost control of the ball, but gathered it long enough to kick out to Daniel on the right wing for a jump shot. The shot missed but Alla was fouled and made one of two free throws for the winning margin.

Kendra Bolen's return from injury along with strong play from Daniel, Burnette, and Danielle Rich led the way.

The ALMS wrestling team won their matches against both William Byrd and Glenvar. Lewis was scheduled to wrestle at Clifton Forge Wednesday and Saturday is the annual middle school tournament at Northside.

The basketball teams both play at home today. The girls are scheduled to play at 4:30 pm with the boys to follow.
