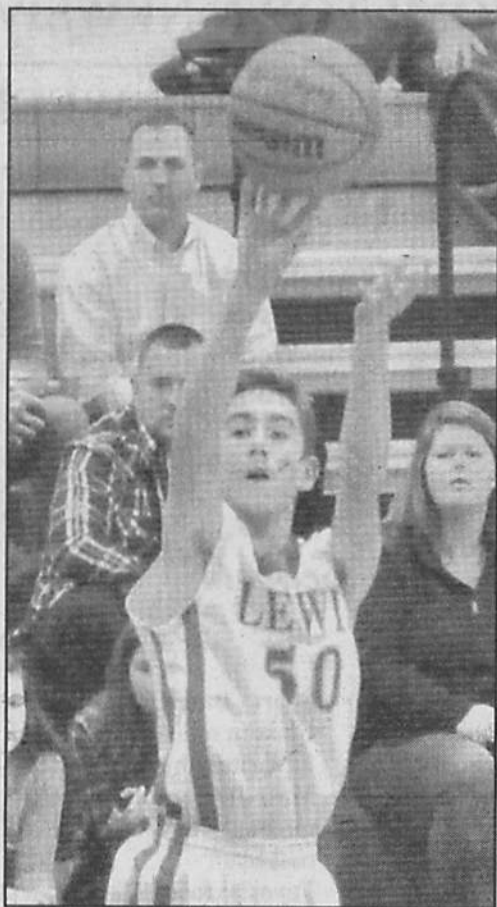


Right, Alex Blanchard takes a shot for the Lewis boys' basketball team. Below, Kenzie Smith handles the ball for the girls' team.
