

# Wolverine basketball teams have doubleheader at Fleming Saturday

The Andrew Lewis basketball teams will play a "girls-boys" doubleheader on Saturday morning against Breckenridge Middle School at William Fleming High School.

The girls will open the doubleheader at 9 am, followed by the boys game at 10:15 am. Both teams also play Cave Spring today, with the girls at home and the boys at Cave Spring.

The girls remained undefeated with a win over Central Academy on Tuesday. Lewis also beat Hidden Valley last Thursday, almost shutting out the Eagles in a 42-2 win. Samantha Mitchem and Kendra Fredrick had eight points each to lead Lewis, and Moriah Hill had six points. Mitchem also had five boards and three blocked shots while Malaysia Donaldson had five steals and Sydney Byrd had four assists.

"This was one of our best defensive efforts of the season," said coach Nat Franklin. "The girls did a great job moving the ball and finishing every offensive possession, especially in the second half."

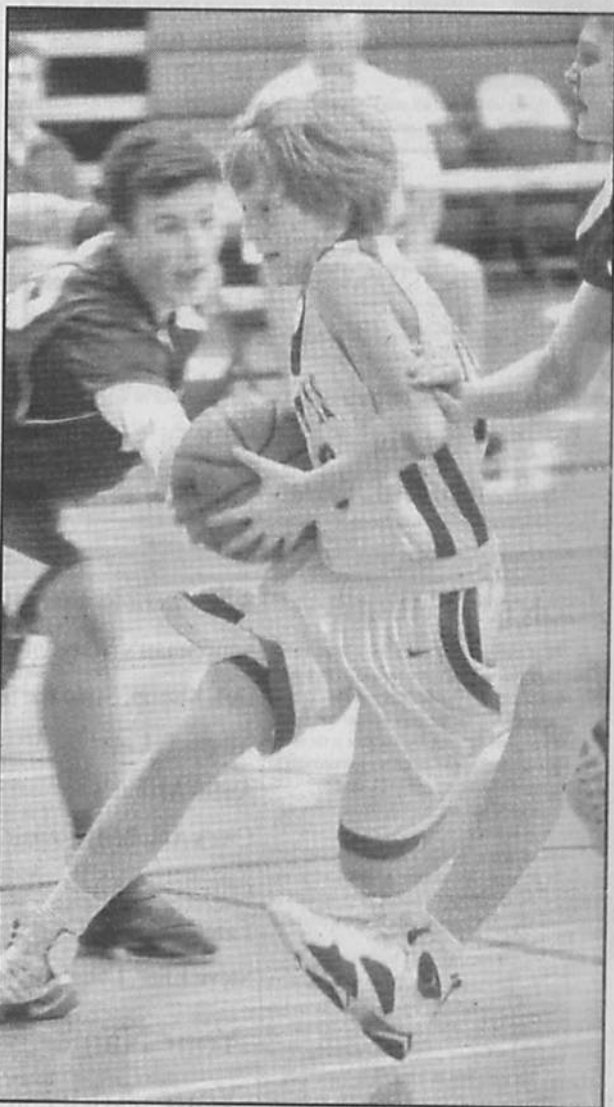
The Lewis boys won their second straight match Tuesday, defeating Central Academy.
